



Call For Athletes – SNOWBOARDING

The National Deaf Snowboarding Program is looking to identify, select, and train athletes who have the potential, experience, and ability to represent Canada at the international level. The focus for this Snowboarding Camp is to select and finalize Team Canada for the 2015 Winter Deaflympics in Khanty-Mansiysk, Russia, March 28th – April 5th.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the National Snowboarding Program all athletes must have a hearing loss of at least 55dB in the better ear (three frequency pure tone average at 500, 1000, and 2000Hz).

Identification and Selection Camps

The National Snowboarding Program hosted a Western Selection Camp in May 2014 in Calgary AB, and will be hosting an Eastern Selection Camp in Mont Tremblant, QC, January 2015. Athletes do not need to attend both camps, but are welcome to. (Travel and accommodation are the responsibility of the athlete) Team Canada final selections from both camps will be made upon completion of the Eastern camp.
